Parenting Tips for the early school years

Promoting Independence (Part 4)..... While 3-and 4-year-olds still need plenty of parental help, preschool experts agree that kids are typically able to do more than many of us think. Here's how you can encourage them:

Let them solve simple problems. If you see your child trying to assemble a toy or get a book from a shelf that is hard to reach, pause before racing over to help. "Provided that they are safe, those moments when you don't rush in, when you give your children a moment to solve things for themselves, those are the character-building moments," says Zebooker. "It's natural to want to make everything perfect, but if we do, we cheat kids of the chance to experience success."

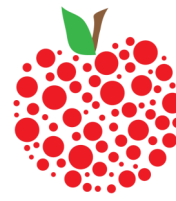


Capital V. Start at the top strawberry line and draw a slanted line down to the bottom chocolate
