Parenting Tips for the early school years

Promoting Independence (Part 2)..... While 3-and 4-year-olds still need plenty of parental help, preschool experts agree that kids are typically able to do more than many of us think. Here's how you can encourage them:

Resist doing for them what they can do for themselves. While it may be quicker and easier to do it yourself, it won't help to make your child more self-sufficient. Quick hint: Appeal to their sense of pride, suggests Donna Jones, a preschool teacher at Southern Oregon University's Schneider Children's Center in Ashland, Oregon. "Whenever I'm trying to get kids dressed, put on jackets, sit on chairs during meals and so on, I'll ask them: 'Do you want me to help you or can you do it yourself?'" Those words are like magic," promises Jones. "The kids always want to do it for themselves."



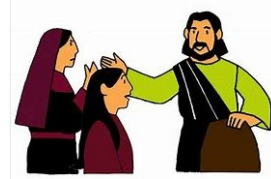

The "P,p" homework paper comes home Friday, March 1st and is due Thursday, March 7th.



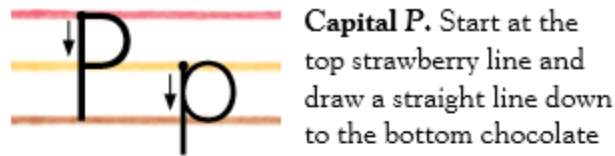

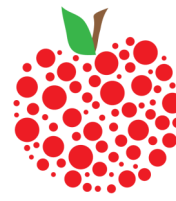

Just before the middle vanilla line, curve up and around to form a circle that sits on the bottom chocolate line and comes back to your first straight line.
